Goodland Regional Medical Center continues to focus on serving the community with high-quality care and well-equipped facilities.

Our dedicated clinic providers delivered care for more than 15,000 patient visits in 2023, and our skilled Emergency Department team provided essential care for 2,600 patient visits. Also in 2023, GRMC invested more than \$300,000 in capital equipment purchases and building maintenance, and opened our revitalized Wound Care Center. When you add in all the ancillary services (such as imaging and lab tests), rehabilitation sessions, IV therapy sessions, hospital care and surgical procedures that took place over the past year, it's clear how vital GRMC is to this community.

And this community is vital to GRMC! We fully understand that the equation goes both ways. Our board of directors and leadership know that you and your family have choices about where to seek healthcare. Every day we work hard to continue to earn your patronage. As I write this note in March 2024, I'm pleased to announce that we have recently added a full-time, double-board-certified podiatrist to the GRMC medical staff—Thomas Eddy, DPM—as well as three specialist consultants via telemedicine, in nephrology, rheumatology and endocrinology.

Electromyography Machine (EMG Machine): Purchased with Goodland Regional Medical Center Foundation golf tournament proceeds. Providing nerve conduction studies, which is the study to find and evaluate damage to nerves and help diagnose nerve disorders such as carpal tunnel syndrome (wrist) or cubital tunnel syndrome (elbow).

Ultrasound Table: Purchased with funding from Goodland Regional Medical Center Auxiliary and Sherman County Community Foundation Match Day.

Surgical Equipment: Olympus monitor and cardiac vital signs machines.

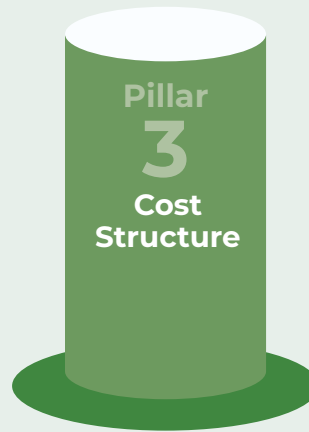
GRMC Strategic Plan
